CF-Plus Small Breed

ICSB's Canine Fertility Supplement – Small Breed (CF-Plus SB) can aid in improvement of canine sperm production, testicular size and tone, and ease the effects of arthritis. In females, our supplement has shown to stabilize estrous cycles, thus eliminating silent, weak, or split cycles. We recommend this supplement for study that have shown low sperm count, quality, or soft testes.

Directions For Use:

In the male, one tablet for each 15 pounds body weight, daily, for 90 days. Divide the daily dosage between morning and evening. After 90 days, collect semen specimen and compare to that first initially observed.

In the female, one tablet for each 15 pounds body weight, beginning approximately 60-90 days before onset of estrus. Continue for 60 days.

Once the desired sperm quality or estrous regularity is attained, we recommend placing the dog on a maintenance dosage of one tablet for each 30 pounds, daily. If any decrease in sperm quality or estrous regularity occurs, increase dosage to the original recommended amount.

Active Ingredients per Tablet:

Green-Lipped Mussel (*Perna canaliculus*) 300 mg

Inactive Ingredients: alfalfa, brewers yeast, microcrystalline cellulose, silicon dioxide, stearic acid, vegetable stearate.
